

TENDER ANNOUNCEMENT

In accordance with the procedure specified in Article 70¹ of the Polish Civil Code for the purchase of lenses for a thermal imaging monocular

I. Preliminary provisions

1. The tender shall be held in accordance with Articles 70¹ and 70³-70⁵ of the Polish Civil Code.
2. The organizer of the tender is the Polish Society for Nature Conservation "Salamandra" with its headquarters at 7/3 Stolarska St., 60-788 Poznan, Poland, hereinafter referred to as the "Society".

II. Subject of the tender

The subject of the tender is the purchase of brand new lenses for the Pulsar Helion 2 XP PRO monocular thermal imager:

- 1) Pulsar Vision F28 thermal imaging lens;
- 2) Pulsar Vision F38 thermal imaging lens.

Offers for the purchase of each of these devices will be considered separately and the purchase of each lens may constitute a separate order – also from a different supplier. Partial offers for only one of these devices are acceptable.

It is required that the equipment is covered by a warranty or guarantee, the scope of which must be specified in the offer.

III. Delivery date and place

Delivery within a maximum of 21 days after the tender allotment must be made to the headquarters of the Society, listed in I.2 (the price offered is to include the cost of delivery).

IV. Tender conditions

1. Offers must be sent by 03.04.2023 11:00 a.m. CEST in electronic form at biuro@salamandra.org.pl (the time of receipt of the offer on the Society's mail server is counted).
2. The bidder shall be bound by the offer within 30 days from the date of submission of the offer.
3. The offer shall be legibly written in English or Polish and shall contain:
 - 1) the name and surname or company name of the bidder, as well as the address and contact information (telephone, e-mail);

- 2) net and gross price for the offered device (including delivery costs), please indicate if the bid includes transferred VAT;
 - 3) information on the country in which the seller is registered (for the purpose of calculating any tax and customs costs);
 - 4) information on the duration of the warranty or guarantee and its scope.
4. Offers must be submitted separately for each lens, and it is possible to submit an offer for only one of the lenses. Each offer must clearly and precisely specify the type of device offered, indicating that it matches the type of thermal imaging scope indicated in the announcement. In the case of bids for both devices, the cost of delivery can be listed separately, including giving separate options for the shipment of one or two devices.

6. In the tender, applications, notices and information shall be provided by the Society and bidders in writing or electronically (including by posting on the website).

V. Evaluation of the offers

1. Evaluation of offers will be carried out in two stages.
2. The evaluation of offers will be carried out by a person or persons designated by the Society.
3. In the first stage, the Society shall read the offers and check whether the offers meet the formal requirements of the Announcement of tender.
4. The Society rejects an offer if:
 - 1) it was submitted after the specified deadline or in an improper manner;
 - 2) does not meet the conditions specified in Part II;
 - 3) is invalid under separate regulations.
5. If, on the basis of the offer, the Society has doubts about whether the offered equipment meets the conditions specified in Part II, it may ask the bidder for additional clarification and information.
6. In the second stage, the Society shall select the most advantageous offer from among these not rejected in the first stage, the only criterion being the price (the cheapest offer is selected). The total gross cost of the purchase is taken into account, including the

transportation costs per lens, as well as any customs duties and customs clearance costs (applies to offers from outside the EU).

7. The person or persons designated by the Society after the selection of the most advantageous offer shall draw up a protocol of the tender.

8. The Society shall notify the result of the tender or the closure of the tender without selection immediately after the tender allotment or the closure without selection by posting the relevant information, as an attachment to the information on the tender announcement, on the website at <http://salamandra.org.pl/zamowieniapubliczne.html>.

9. After the selection of the most advantageous offer, the Society shall additionally inform the bidder who submitted it.

10. If the bidder evades full and proper execution of the assignment within the timeframe indicated in Section IV, the Society may entrust this assignment to the bidder whose bid was next in order, provided that the bidding period has not expired.

VI. Final provisions

The Society reserves the right to:

- 1) cancel the tender, either in whole or in part at any time, in particular in cases of:
 - a) failure to submit at least one bid meeting the requirements of the tender,
 - b) if all offers meeting the requirements of the tender will contain a price higher than the amount available to the Society for this purpose,
- 2) closing the tender without selecting an offer;
- 3) change the deadlines set in the announcement;
- 4) demand detailed information and explanations from bidders at any stage of the tender;
- 5) to exclusively interpret the provisions of the announcement.
